REPORTS

Treasurer's Report:

Withdrawals of \$2596.43 The current balance in the DAA account is \$22,230.65 as of 09/30.

Any other expenses taken on by members for DAA promotion during the Miracle on Main event will be considered with receipts at a future 2026 meeting.

The Annual Meeting will be 11/17 and every member can bring a plus 1 but additional guests will be \$10.

Other Business:

Stacey VanEnkevort is asking DAA to help disperse the Rec department survey to gauge public feedback about village and downtown events.
